

Letme Cook Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy is designed to help you understand your privacy choices when you visit the LetmeCook website or use the LetmeCook mobile application. This Privacy Policy does not apply to other websites or services that we do not control, including websites or products and services of third parties, and does not apply to your sharing of information with other users of the LetmeCook mobile application.

This Privacy Policy is incorporated into, and forms an integral part of, the LetmeCook EULA. Unless otherwise defined below, the terms used herein have the same meanings as in the LetmeCook EULA.

Definitions

Service

Service means the LetmeCook website and the LetmeCook mobile application.

Personal Data

Personal Data means data that can be used to identify or contact a single person.

Usage Data

Usage Data is data automatically collected either through use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

Data Collection and Use

We collect Personal Data when you create an account with us or contact us. We collect Usage Data when you use the Service.

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

We may ask you to provide us with certain Personal Data, such as your:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number
- Physical address

We use your Personal Data to ensure the secure use of the LetmeCook mobile application, to respond to communications from you, and to send you communications regarding our Service, including Change notices and promotional materials. You may opt out of receiving promotional communications by following the unsubscribe link or the instructions provided in the communication.

Usage Data

We may collect Usage Data whenever you use our Service.

This Usage Data may include device information, IP address, operating system and version, the browser type and version, pages visited, time and date of visit, time spent on pages, unique device identifiers, and diagnostic data. When you use our mobile application, we may also collect login information and information related to how you use our application.

Location Data

We may use and store data about your location if you give us permission to do so. We use this data to provide features of our Service, and to improve and customize our Service. You can enable or disable location services by way of your device settings.

Cookies And Other Tracking Technologies

We use cookies, beacons, tags, scripts and similar tracking technologies to help us better understand user behavior, tell us which parts of our Service people have visited, facilitate and measure the effectiveness of advertisements, personalize the Service, and to generally improve our Service. We treat information collected by cookies and other technologies as non-personal information. You can disable cookies using your device or browser settings. However, certain features of the Service may not be available if you disable cookies.

Examples of Cookies we use:

- **Session.** We use Session Cookies to operate our Service.
- **Preference.** We use Preference Cookies to remember your preferences and settings.
- **Security.** We use Security Cookies for security purposes.

Use of Data

We use the Personal and Usage Data we collect for various purposes, including:

- To provide and maintain our Service
- To notify you about changes to our Service
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our Service
- To provide customer support
- To gather information to improve our Service
- To monitor the usage of our Service
- To detect, prevent and address technical issues
- To provide you with news, special offers and general information about other goods, services and events which we offer

Disclosure of Data

We may disclose Personal and Usage Data to third parties:

- To comply with any legal obligation
- To protect and defend our rights or property
- To prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the Service
- To protect the personal safety of users of the Service or the public
- To protect against legal liability
- In the event of a merger, acquisition, or dissolution of our company
- As necessary in order to provide you with the Service

Security of Data

We use commercially reasonable means to protect the security of your Personal Data. However, no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure, so we cannot guarantee the security of your Personal Data.

Service Providers

We may share Personal Data with companies and individuals who provide services to us, such as information processing, customer support, data management and analysis, and other services related to our providing the Service to you. These third parties have access to your Personal Data only to perform these tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use it for any other purpose.

Links to Other Sites

Our Service may contain links to other sites that are not operated by us. If you click a third-party link within the Service, you will be directed to that third party's site. We have no control over and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies, or practices of any third-party sites or services.

Children's Privacy

Our Service is not intended for use by anyone under the age of 18. We do not knowingly collect Personal Data from anyone under the age of 18. If we learn that we have collected Personal Data from anyone under the age of 18, we will take steps to delete the Personal Data as soon as possible.

Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may make changes to our Privacy Policy from time to time. If we make a material change to our Privacy Policy, we will notify you by sending an email to the address identified in your account or by posting a revised version of the Privacy Policy incorporating the changes to our website. Such changes will be applied on a prospective basis beginning on the date the changes are posted to our website or the date we send the email notice to the email address identified in your account, whichever occurs first.
